Job Vacancies

Lunchtime Supervisor

With effect from September, we shall have a vacancy for a Lunchtime Supervisor. The role mainly entails supervising the children whilst they are eating in the hall and on the outside playground during the lunchtime break, and administering first aid as necessary. This is for 5 days a week from 12.00 until 1.10pm. This is a term time only post (194 days per year) and paid monthly on the last Wednesday of the month.
